



The Sudbury Symphony Orchestra Presents A Tribute to Liberace, Oct. 19

SSO Sparkling features classical favourites and trademark showmanship

Sudbury, ON Oct. 17: More than just the colour of the leaves will be changing this Saturday, as the Sudbury Symphony Orchestra switches things up adding a bit of flair and colour to their 8 p.m. classical performance at Glad Tidings Tabernacle.

Renowned guest conductor, Maestro Brian Jackson, will take the stage with the symphony to not only direct the orchestra, but perform as featured soloist in the Orchestra's **tribute to Liberace**, appropriately dubbed "**SSO Sparkling.**"

Liberace, an American pianist and vocalist is best known as an entertainer who embraced a flashy and colourful lifestyle, both on and off stage. His life was recently the subject of an HBO Film, "**Behind the Candelabra,**" which won the **2013 Emmy Award** for Outstanding Miniseries or Movie.

Not to be outdone, the Sudbury Symphony's concert will feature the **glitzy costumes**, showmanship, witty banter and the candelabras Liberace is known for. This fun-filled concert promises to have music that will be familiar to many first-time audience members, including selections from ***The Sound Of Music***, "Memory" from Andrew Lloyd Webber's hit musical ***Cats***, and Rimsky-Korsakov's ***Flight of the Bumblebee***.

Maestro Jackson is a familiar face to the Sudbury Symphony, having conducted two concerts to **near sold-out audiences** in their 12.13 season, including "Last Night of the Proms," and "A Viennese New Year Celebration." He has held the title of Principal Pops Conductor with a number of Canadian orchestras and has conducted the Toronto Symphony Orchestra, National Arts Centre Orchestra and Vancouver Symphony, among others.
